

The village of Head of The Harbor is pleased to announce an exhibit of rare Toni Frissell photographs from private collections, scheduled for May 29th, 2015 at Village Hall located at 500 North Country Road, St. James NY 11780. Opens at 5pm.

Toni Frissell (March 10, 1907 - April 17, 1988) a former resident of The Village of The Head of The Harbor, was one of the 20th century's top fashion photographers & photo journalists. She is credited with inventing the out-door-on-location photo shoot.

Frissell photographed many luminaries of her day such as Winston Churchill, The Kennedy-Bouvier wedding and the heroic Tuskegee Airmen.

Also on exhibit will be some of the books Toni Frissell created such as; "A Child's Garden of Verses" (1944), "Bermuda:The Happy Island" (1946), "Mother Goose" (1948), "The King Ranch", 1939-1944 (1965).

In addition to actual period photographs, there will be various vintage Vogue/Life/look magazines, and most importantly a copy of "Toni Frissell: Photographs 1933 - 1967" authored by Toni's daughter, the late Sidney Stafford, a noted photographer in her own right. Members of Frissell/Bacon family will be in attendance as well as former sitters.

Included will be a coordinated micro-exhibit on the Frissell/Bacon family's historic Head of Harbor home called "Sherrewogue", that was redesigned by Stanford White 1895, which will feature items on loan from Smithtown Historical Society and Long Island Reading Room at Smithtown Public Library.
